General Assembly meeting Istanbul Turkey 18-20 November 2019

The new Platform

- 25 organisations applied and accepted as member of LSI
- 2 associate members (Esperanza/ALC)

General Assembly can suggest new members to be invited and will approve new members annually

Organisations can also directly apply for membership



Agreed Services LSI Platform

- Exchange/sharing of experiences & practises
 (challenges; practical information grass root work)
- Direct referral and cooperation regarding THB cases
- Sharing facts/information (legal/political developments)
- Common awareness and advocacy Ensure visibility of the work of the platform and make more use of available data of platform members
- Joining forces in order to stand firm as civil society (consultations, technical/financial cooperation and support, capacity building)

Structure of the Platform

- General Assembly (all full members responsible for solutions related to articles, membership, annual programme and budget; election board members)
- International board (minimum 3 members, acting on behalf of GA and responsible for execution decisions GA)
- Possible Advisory council (not established yet)
- LSI Secretariat (daily management)
- Ad hoc working groups (to be defined by GA)

Membership criteria

- Being an (independent) NGO organisation in Europe
- Active on the issue of human trafficking at grass root level, preferably by providing direct support
- Demonstrated and recognised expertise in and commitment to the Anti-Trafficking field at the national level for at least 3 years.
- Adhering to the common vision and values of LSI
- Recognising the Statute of LSI and complying with its Code of Conduct
- Committed to actively participate in LSI Platform

Members' responsibilities

- Members should be active, share information and support each other (solidarity) – this includes:
- Attend and actively participate in meetings/events;
- Bring expertise/experience by sharing best practices, engaging in discussions and sharing data;
- Support LSI initiatives, including joint statements;
- Promote trust and transparency

Members' Rights

- Access to timely, clear and up to date information
- Access to regular meetings (at least annually)
- Equal vote in decision-making
- Access to participation in (and initiation of) projects
- Membership can be stopped at any time



Vote: Proposed Amendments to the Statute

- Name: La Strada International (LSI) NGO Platform or La Strada International (LSI)
- General Assembly (rather than General Meeting)
- Criteria: Non-governmental legal entities at the national level in Europe (non profit)
- Meetings: General Assembly meets once a year (rather than twice)
- Quorum: Valid resolutions can only be adopted when 75% of the total number of members are present.
- Board members: can be a representative of a member organisation or external expert
